Dr. Noble is the Clinical Director of the Patient Safety Reporting System at the New Jersey Department of Health and has served in this position for 10 years. She is responsible for the oversight of the mandatory reporting program for serious preventable adverse events.

Dr. Noble received her medical degree and MPH from the University of Medicine and Dentistry of NJ-Robert Wood Johnson Medical School. She is board certified in Public Health-General Preventive Medicine and Family Medicine. She also completed a fellowship in Health Services Research and Quality Assurance.
